## VOLUNTEER LONG TABLE LUNCH

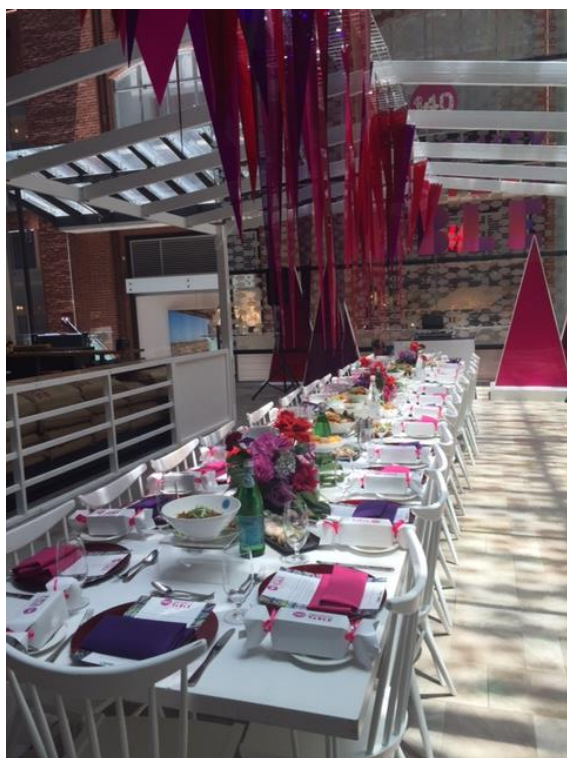
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In December, we were invited to celebrate some of our amazing volunteers at a Longe Table Lunch held at 140 William Street.
